REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FLOWOOD, RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI Held November 7, 2022

6:30 P.M.

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Flowood met at their regular meeting place on November 7, 2022, at 6:30 P.M.

The following members were present: Mayor Gary Rhoads, Alderman Deron Harmon, Alderman Kathy Smith, Alderman Don Flynt, and Alderman Seth Robbins.

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Rhoads.

The invocation was given Alderman Smith.

Item #1 – Public Hearing regarding the City Stormwater Management Plan– Paul Forster

The required public notice (copy attached) having been given; the Mayor opened the public hearing on the above matter. Paul Forster presented a summary of the city stormwater management program. A copy of Paul Forster's discussion agenda is attached. The Mayor asked if anyone else desired to speak regarding the city stormwater management plan. No one requested to speak. The Mayor closed the public hearing. No action was taken by the Board.

Item # 2 — Tabled Public Hearing from October 17, 2022, pursuant to MCA 21-19-11 regarding determination of a public nuisance at 2925 Flowood Drive (Parcel #'s F10J000003 and F10J000004) — Rusty Fortenberry

Rusty Fortenberry advised the Board that the owner cleaned the property, and no action is necessary.

Item #3 – Tabled Public Hearing from October 17, 2022, pursuant to MCA 21-19-11 regarding determination of a public nuisance at 3905 Underwood Drive and 3825 Willow Drive (Parcel # E09M000004) - Rusty Fortenberry

Rusty Fortenberry advised the Board that the property owner had disconnected the utilities, located a dumpster on site, and started demolishing the dilapidated structures. Rusty Fortenberry requested that the Board table this matter to allow the owner more time to clean the property.

Item #4 - Approval Of Resolution declaring the intention of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Flowood, Mississippi, to issue Taz Increment Financing Bonds of said municipality in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed Five Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,500,000) to finance the cost of installing and constructing certain improvements for the Flowood Town Center, a high quality mixed use development center within said city, in accordance with Chapter 45 of Title 21, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, and determining that the Flowood Town Center Project is a project eligible for Tax Increment Financing according to said Act; and that a public hearing be conducted in connection with the Tax Increment Financing Plan for said project; and for related purposes - Rusty Fortenberry
